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MSD Notice of Construction

Greenpine Acres Pump Station Elimination

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) will be eliminating the pump station located behind 1078 Persimmon Court and installing approximately 2,180 feet of 12-inch gravity sewer. The new sewer line will run northwest from a manhole in front of 10085 Hamilton Avenue to the pump station behind 1078 Persimmon Court. Work is anticipated to begin in early January 2015 and be completed by Spring 2015.

This project, located in Springfield Township, will eliminate sewer backups caused by the pump station and provide access to sanitary sewer service to two additional households.

Construction will occur primarily Monday through Thursday during daylight hours, depending on weather and the contractor's schedule. Work on Fridays or weekends may be necessary at times. MSD's construction contractor is Welsh Excavation Company, Inc.

The Greenpine Acres Pump Station Elimination project is part of MSD's Project Groundwork, which is one of the largest public works projects in the 200-year history of Hamilton County. Project Groundwork was developed in response to federal and state mandates to better manage combined sewer overflows and other stormwater issues. It is a multi-year initiative comprised of hundreds of sewer improvements and stormwater control projects across MSD's service area. These projects will improve the quality of our lives through cleaner streams, improved protection of public health, and enhance the communities where we live, work, and play. Our communities will be cleaner and more environmentally and economically sustainable.
